Admission to B.A.LL.B.(Hons.) & B.Com.LL.B.(Hons.) Degree Course for the Academic Year 2017-2018 under Non-Resident Indians (NRI) Quota

1. Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission to B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) & B.Com. LL.B. (Hons.) Degree Course offered by Tamil Nadu National Law School, Tiruchirappalli-620009 for the academic year 2017-2018, under Non-Resident Indian (NRI) Quota.

2. Total number of Seats – 6

(i) B.A. LL.B.(Hons.) - 3

(ii) B.Com. LL.B.(Hons.) - 3

3. Eligibility Criteria

Admission to the NRI quota will be made in the following order and as per merit on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in the qualifying examination (Plus Two Examination). The candidates seeking admission under NRI quota should have secured not less than 60% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination. The marks obtained in the 12th standard excluding language subjects shall be reckoned for deciding inter-se merit. [CANDIDATES SEEKING ADMISSION UNDER NRI QUOTA NEED NOT HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE COMMON LAW ADMISSION TEST].

4. Categories

Three different categories of applicants will be considered for admission under NRI Quota as indicated below:

Category-I: NRI parent

The Parent (Father or Mother) of candidates seeking admission should be a NRI.

Category-II: NRI Guardian

If the candidate has no parent where he/she has been taken as a ward by a near relative or someone and such NRI guardian has been legally declared as the guardian of the candidate by the Court as per the provision of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.

Category- III: NRI Sponsor

The sponsor under this category has to submit a certificate indicating the relationship with the candidate so sponsored

NOTE:

- i) Only if sufficient number of candidates are not available under category-I, will category-II be considered. The category-III (NRI Sponsor) shall be considered for admission only when sufficient number of candidate are not available under categories I & II.
- ii) In each and every category, candidates will be selected based only on inter-se merit.

5. Documents to be furnished

Candidates applying under NRI quota must furnish the attested photo copies of the following documents along with the filled-in application:

- a) NRI status certificate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective country with seal.
- b) Copy of the NRE (Non Resident External) or NRO Bank account pass book of the NRI.

- c) Copy of the valid Passport of the NRI
- d) Proof of relationship between the NRI and the candidate in the form of notarised affidavit stating the relationship
- e) Qualifying mark / grade sheet of the candidate
- f) Certificate showing that the candidate has proficiency in English language.
- g) School/College Transfer Certificate or Migration Certificate wherever necessary.

If the applicant fails to furnish any of the above documents, TNNLS reserve the right to reject the application.

The candidates provisionally selected under NRI quota will be admitted only after verification of all original documents. They should surrender all the original certificates at the time of admission for verification. On the date of admission, if any candidate fails to produce all the original certificates referred above he/she will not be considered for admission and provisional admission granted will be withdrawn. Extension of time will not be given for producing the original certificates.

On verification, if any discrepancy is noticed between information furnished in the application form and original documents produced, the selection will be cancelled.

Tamil Nadu National Law School, reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate for valid reasons.

7. Mode of obtaining application

Application for admission under NRI quota can be downloaded from the website of the Tamil Nadu National Law School (www.tnnls.in) or obtained directly from the Registrar's Office, Tamil Nadu National Law School, Tiruchirappalli. The cost of application is US \$ 250/- only. The mode of payment of application fee is as follows:
