Applications are invited for the post of "Resident Warden" and "Sub-Warden" on contract basis initially for a period of one year, for the Hostels (Men & Women) which has student strength of around 300. Tamil Nadu National Law School is a Residential University and presently offers B.A. LL.B.(Hons.) and B.Com. LL.B.(Hons.) courses. Students from all over India are admitted to these courses through common law admission test.

Prescribed qualifications:

A degree in any discipline

Three years' experience as Warden in a University or Government or any Public Sector Institution;


Preference shall be given to B.Ed. degree holders.

Retired Police / Military Officers can also apply with or without experience as Warden as indicated above.

The Resident Warden and Sub-Warden are required to reside in the hostel and are eligible to avail the mess facility of the hostel free of charge. He/She may be sanctioned weekly holiday of one day, if required.

The Resident Warden / Sub-Warden are responsible for maintenance of discipline of students in the hostel, relevant records and cleanliness apart from supervising the hostel mess (let out on contract basis to private caterers). The Resident Warden / Sub-Warden will report to the Faculty-in-Charge of Hostels and will be under overall supervision of the Registrar / Vice-Chancellor.
